- Maps with local points of interest



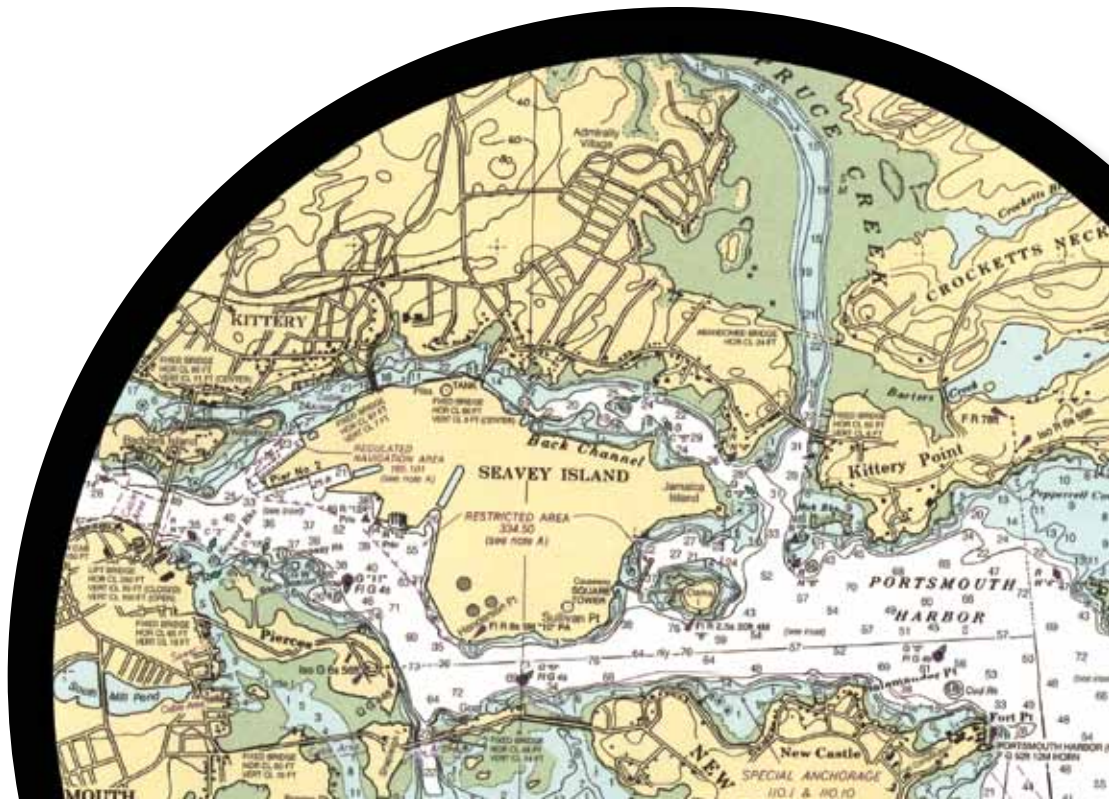
